

DAY 1 – TUESDAY, OCTOBER 8TH:

Meet in St. George and depart on motorcoach to the airport. Board your overnight flight to Rome, Italy. Meals on the flight.

DAY 2 – WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 9TH:

Upon arrival in Rome, you will be met by your Tour Manager. Board your motorcoach and pick up your Tour Guide. Enjoy a **guided city tour** with visits to:

- *Piazza Navona with its beautiful fountains*
- *Trevi Fountains* and the *Pantheon*

Say goodbye to your guide and visit the **Coliseum** where gladiators fought to the death. Before arriving at your **Group Dinner**, check into your hotel for the next six nights.

DAY 3 – THURSDAY, OCTOBER 10TH:

Breakfast at your hotel. Board your motorcoach and transfer to the **LDS Temple Rome**. Spend the morning there – own arrangements. This afternoon you will enjoy a **performance during Mass in St. Peter's Basilica Vatican City**. Dinner this evening will be on your own. Return to your hotel.

DAY 5 – SATURDAY, OCTOBER 12TH:

Breakfast at your hotel. Following breakfast, board your motorcoach and drive along the **Tiber Valley** to reach the medieval hilltop town of **Orvieto**. Enjoy the magnificent **14th Century Cathedral**, a masterpiece of Italian Gothic architecture. Continue on to **Assisi** and enjoy a guided tour through the alleys of this historic town and see:

- *Church of St. Claire*
- *St. Francis' birthplace and childhood home*
- *Town Hall Square with its' People's Palace and Roman Temple* dedicated to *Minerva*
- *St. Francis' Basilica*
- *Possible Performance at the St. Francis Church* or the *San Rufino Cathedral of Assisi*

Dinner on your own in Assisi and return to your hotel in Rome.

DAY 6 – SUNDAY, OCTOBER 13TH:

Following an early morning Sacrament Meeting and **breakfast** at your hotel, board your motorcoach for a full day excursion to:

- *Mount Vesuvius*
- *Pompeii*

Since exploding into history in AD 79, Vesuvius has blown its top more than 30 times. The last eruption was in 1944. Pompeii, which was a prosperous village with a population of about 25,000, was covered by a layer of ash 20 feet deep. Excavation began in the 18th Century and

revealed Pompeii's wide diversity of building materials and techniques. Following your exploration today, return to Rome for dinner on your own. Return to your hotel.

DAY 7 – MONDAY, OCTOBER 14TH:

Following **breakfast**, visit the Rome Catacombs. The Catacombs of St. Callixtus are among the greatest and most important of Rome. Originating in the second century, 16 Popes and many martyrs and Christians are buried within. Afterwards, enjoy **Dinner** near the **Tiber River**. This evening, participate in a **farewell performance** at **Sant'Ignazio Church**. Return to hotel.

DAY 8 – TUESDAY, OCTOBER 15TH:

Breakfast at your hotel. Check out and transfer to the Rome airport and your return flight home. Motorcoach to St. George.

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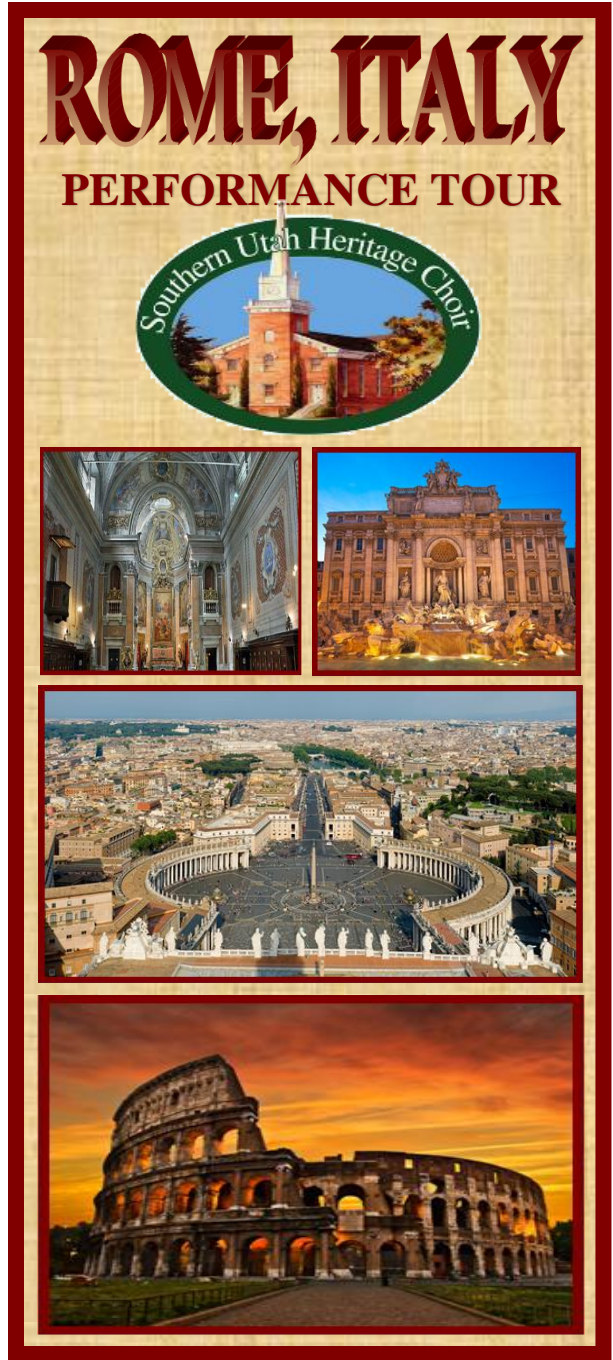
